

Notice of Review

Polling Districts and Polling Places

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council is conducting a review of those polling districts and polling places for the Huntingdon and North West Cambridgeshire Parliamentary Constituencies that fall within the boundaries of Huntingdonshire District Council.
2. This is an interim review, focussing on the parishes of, Huntingdon, St Ives, Fenstanton, St Neots, The Stukeleys and Spaldwick.
3. The Acting Returning Officer for the constituencies will comment on any proposed polling stations.
4. Any elector within the District may make representations concerning either the existing, or proposed arrangements (when published) as to their accessibility with regard to all electors within a particular polling district.
5. The Council particularly welcomes any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to comment on the Council's proposals, or those recommendations of the Acting Returning Officer.
6. The Council's existing arrangements will be published on 25 November 2016 and all comments are to be received by 6 January 2017.
7. Any representations can be made by email to elections@huntingdonshire.gov.uk or post to Huntingdonshire District Council, Pathfinder House, St Mary's Street, Huntingdon PE29 3TN. A list of those persons or bodies making a representation will be published on the Council's website.
8. Final recommendations will be considered by the Council at its meeting on 22 February 2017. Changes will be implemented on the Register of Electors to be republished on 1 March 2017.
