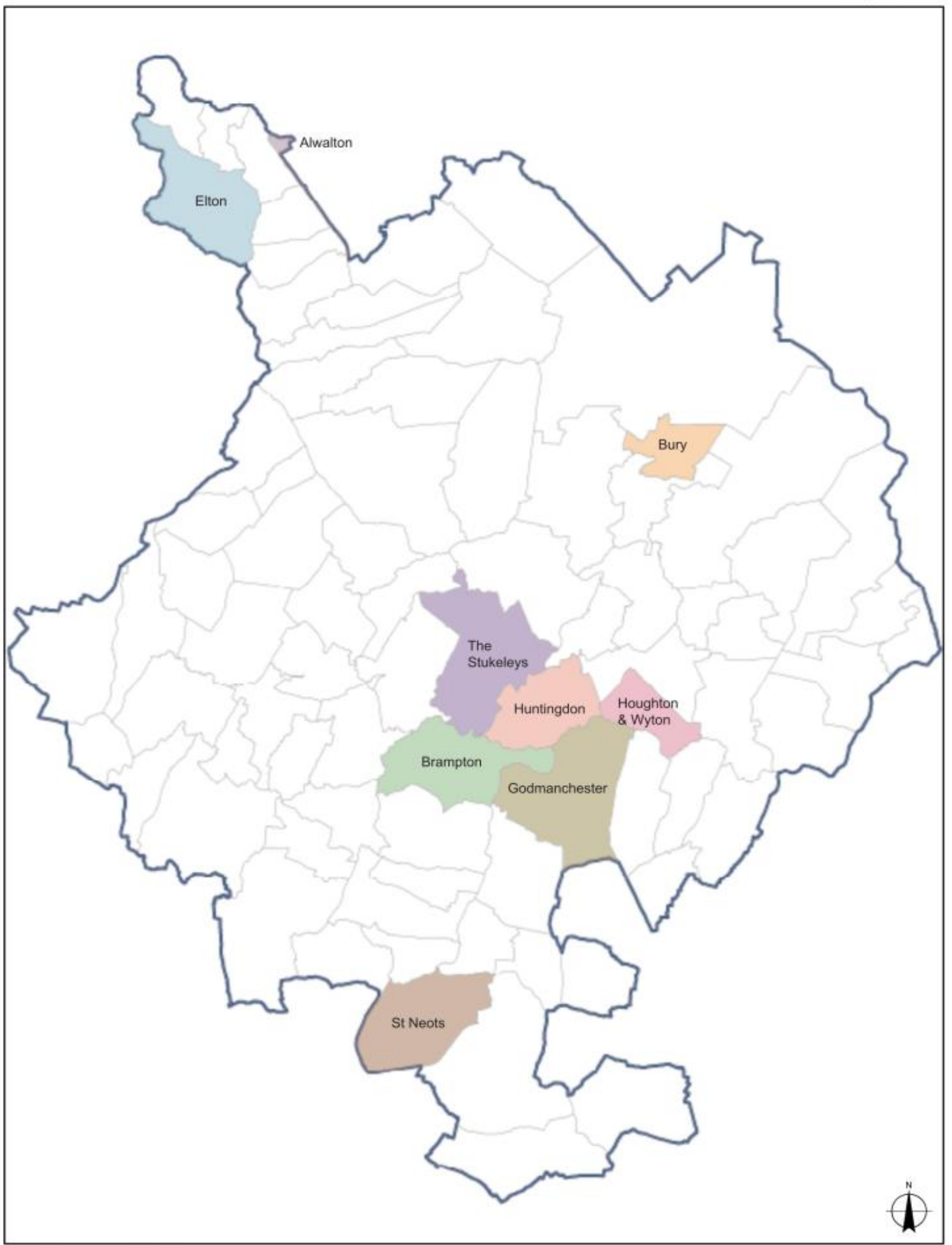


Description: Neighbourhood Planning in Huntingdonshire

Neighbourhood Planning in Huntingdonshire

As illustrated on the map above several town and parish councils in Huntingdonshire have made progress towards preparing a neighbourhood plan. The following tables set out a summary of progress to date and the dates of important milestones. The information contained here was correct as at 17 April 2018.

Town/ Parish	Summary of progress to date
Alwalton	Alwalton Parish Council's application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area relating to the whole of the parish was approved on 30 January 2017.
Brampton	Brampton Parish Council's application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area relating to the whole of the parish was approved on 5 March 2014. The parish council have indicated that they will not be preparing a plan at present.
Bury	Bury Parish Council's application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area relating to the whole of the parish was approved on 7 October 2015. The parish council are currently working on a draft plan.
Elton	Elton Parish Council's application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area relating to the whole of the parish was approved on 12 April 2018.
Godmanchester	The Godmanchester Neighbourhood Plan was 'made' at a meeting of Full Council, on 13 December 2017. The Neighbourhood Plan is now part of the adopted Development Plan.
Houghton and Wyton	The Houghton and Wyton Neighbourhood Plan was 'made' at a meeting of Full Council on 26 March 2018. The Neighbourhood Plan is now part of the adopted Development Plan.
Huntingdon	Huntingdon Town Council's application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area relating to the whole of the parish was approved on 23 April 2015. The town council are currently working on a draft plan.
St Neots	The St Neots Neighbourhood Plan was 'made' at a meeting of Full Council, on 24 February 2016. The Neighbourhood Plan is now part of the adopted Development Plan.
The Stukeleys	The Stukeleys Parish Council's application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area relating to the whole of the parish was approved on 2 June 2016. The parish council are currently working on a draft plan.
