I hope you are well. As you are aware the EiP of the Council's Plan commences on the 17th July 2018 and as we finalise matters I thought it would be useful to provide a further update and having regard to the CBC letter of the 5th Feb 2018 which broadly supports our Plan. Having regard to matters statements from others, in particular on matter 2 DtC I think it would be helpful for us to clarify the CBC position in relation to the St. Neots Eastern Expansion and clarify our mutual position in respect of meeting need.

St. Neots East:

This area comprises 2 planning applications that are both now approved subject to completed of a S106 agreement – 1300388OUT and 17/02308/OUT. Looking at the history of both applications I can see that CBC were actively consulted and responses received on both of those schemes. As the officer reports to committee demonstrate there has been active engagement with neighbouring authorities and stakeholders including Highways England, as the responsible body for the A428. With that in mind it would be very helpful for CBC to clarify that there are no outstanding issues in respect of SEL 2.

Meeting need:

Huntingdonshire district council will meet all of our own need within our administrative boundary and from our previous meeting it was agreed that each of the authorities, namely HDC and CBC would be meeting our own need. I would be grateful if this point could be formally confirmed.

On a broader note, we very much welcome the positive working relationship that we, as neighbouring authorities have fostered, and look forward to maintaining that positive relationship going forward.
