

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

THE STUKELEYS NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN AREA

Referendum on the adoption of the The Stukeleys Neighbourhood Plan

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday, 8th June 2023** to decide on the question below:

‘Do you want Huntingdonshire District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for The Stukeleys to help it decide planning applications for the neighbourhood area?’

2. Applications to be included on the register of electors for this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Monday 22 May 2023**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Pathfinder House, St Mary’s Street, Huntingdon, PE29 3TN by **5 pm on Tuesday, 23rd May 2023**.
4. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector’s Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2023**. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-to-vote
5. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Pathfinder House, St Mary’s Street, Huntingdon, PE29 3TN by **5 pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2023**.
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Pathfinder House, St Mary’s Street, Huntingdon, PE29 3TN by **5 pm on Thursday, 8th June 2023**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2023. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2023.
